Parent Consultation Evenings.

We will be holding parent consultation evenings week commencing 16th October. The appointments slots for the Year 1-6 consultation evenings are now available to book. Appointments for our reception children will be held later on in the year. As with previous years we are offering a mixture of some face to face and some online appointments. Please be careful when booking that you are booking the right type of appointment for you. Face to face slots are clearly labelled 'Face to Face'. All other time slots that do not state this are online appointments only.

To book an appointment, please go to <u>https://studybugs.com/speak</u> to login (**please note - you cannot book this via the app**). Once in, choose 'speak with a teacher' at the top of the screen, and select your child's name. You will see all the available appointments (dates & times) on the right hand side which will specify if they are online or in person slots. Once you have found a slot that works for you - click 'book'. You will be sent an email from studybugs with a summary of the details of the appointment and reminders 30 minutes and 5 minutes before. Please be aware that you will still receive an email with a link and reminders even with a face to face appointment.

Flu vaccinations

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on Wednesday 08/11/2023 to offer your child the Flu vaccination. Yesterday you would have received the following documents via Studybugs:

• A parent letter – containing vaccination information and instructions on how to complete the online consent form. **Please complete a form to either consent or refuse to your child receiving this vaccination**. The online consent form is available for completion until 11am four working days before the session date above. If you have more than one child in the same year group, but they do not attend the same school site, you will receive a separate letter from each school site, to consent for each child, prior to their school's vaccination session. Please use the correct school code for each child.

• How to consent to Flu vaccination guide – a pictorial guide to completing the online consent form. If you have any difficulties completing the online consent form, please contact your local Immunisation Team before the cut-off date, using the telephone number provided in the attached letter. If you miss the cut off time to complete the consent form, they will not be able to vaccinate your child in school on the day of the vaccination session. The consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination, within one of their catch-up clinics. Thank you

Admissions – key dates

Monday 2 October 2023

Online applications open.

You must provide an email address to apply. You can apply online for your child's school place by visiting westsussex.gov.uk/admissions.

Schools will have their prospectuses available and will have arranged open events.

Monday 15 January 2024

National closing date for starting school applications.

You must submit your completed application by this date. Failure to do so will affect the priority attached to your application.

Tuesday 16 April 2024

National offer day.

Applicants will be notified which school their child is offered by email, where an email address is supplied.

Making an online application

To make an application using the online system you will need:

- an email address; and
- create an account on Parent Portal if you do not already have an account.

Your Username will be your email address

Your password must adhere to the following rules. It must:

- be at least 8 characters long
- have at least one character that is UPPERCASE;
- have at least one character that is lowercase.
- have at least one special
- character (such as: * ! \$); ar
- have at least one number.

How to apply

If your child's date of birth is between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 it is now time to apply for their school place. You need to apply online by visiting westsussex.gov.uk/admissions

Please be aware that the email address which you provide will be shared with your preference schools and allocated school, as parents and schools increasingly communicate electronically.

If you do not have access to the internet, free access to apply for a school place is available in all West Sussex libraries.

The website provides information needed for completing your application, including details of all the schools in West Sussex, your catchment school and important information for parents. Please read it carefully before making your application.

There are some benefits to applying online and we strongly advise all parents to do so. However, if you really can't access the internet you can obtain a paper form by calling **03330 142 903**.

Please note, you must provide a valid email address with your application in order to receive the outcome of your school offer.

You must apply on time

It is very important that you apply before the closing date of **Monday 15 January 2024**.

If your application is received after the closing date of **Monday 15 January 2024** your chance of securing a place at one of your preference schools could be seriously affected.

Applications received after the closing date of **Monday 15 January 2024** are late applications and will only be considered after all those that were received on time.

It is your responsibility as a parent to ensure that your application is received by The Pupil Admission Team on time.



Your preferences

We advise all parents to think very carefully about their three preferences and to use them wisely.

School places are allocated according to the published oversubscription criteria for that school. This can include criteria such as whether you live in the catchment area, whether there are siblings already at the school and the distance you live from the school.

Please be realistic in your preferences. You have a higher priority for local schools. If you chose an oversubscribed school, the further away you live the less likely you are to be offered a place.

Please note that personal circumstances, such as child care arrangements, are not part of the oversubscription criteria for any school and will not be taken into consideration.

Finally, we always advise parents to include their catchment school as one of their three preferences.
