Rule of Law: School rules and behaviours; behaviours and consequences; conformity and security

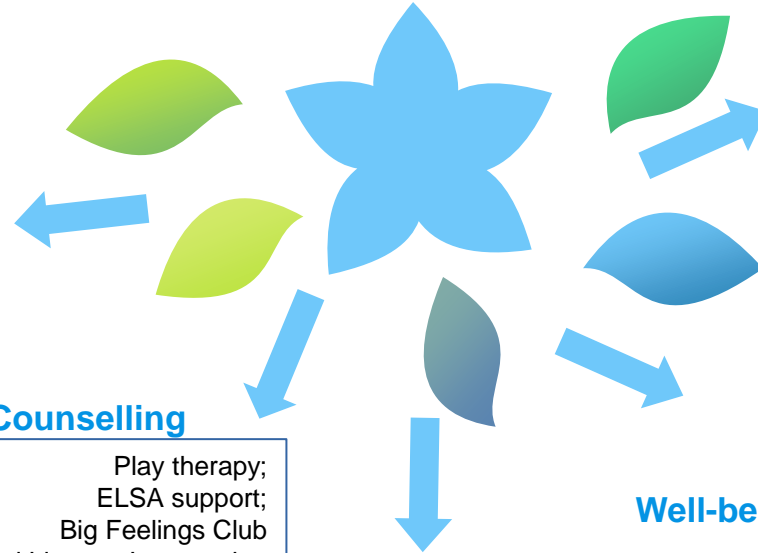
Liberty: religious freedom, inclusivity, PSHE and RE, inclusive books, free choice time, autonomy and individuality
