

School Crossing Patrol

We have had a few people asking for an update on the replacement of our lovely Lollypop man Keith who retired at the beginning of last year.

WSCC are currently reassessing all their school crossing patrol sites. We have been back in contact with them, and they have confirmed they will be reassessing our site and completing a new risk assessment in the next few months. As a historical site for a lollypop person, they are confident we will be successful in still meeting the requirements for a crossing patrol. Until this time, they cannot advertise a specific position at North Lancing.

In the meantime if anyone knows of someone who would like to become a lollypop person, they can apply by emailing SCP@westsussex.gov.uk. If they state they would like to be based at North Lancing, they can start the training and checks and be put on a holding position until the assessment at North Lancing is completed. Although exact times vary from site to site, the commitment is usually 30-40 minutes each morning and afternoon when children are walking to and from school. The rate of pay is currently £10.60 per hour. They only work in term time, so the salary is spread equally over 12 months. Finding a replacement is the hardest part so please ask around in the community.


