Swimming after half term

As you know, swimming will start up again after the May half term. The cost of swimming for the summer term is just £12 via ParentPay.

We are extremely lucky to have our own heated pool here; having a pool onsite means that we do not have to pay transport costs to go to a pool, meaning that the cost for lessons is much cheaper. However, running a pool is extremely expensive so we do need all parents to pay for this please.

Children will need swimming costumes (no bikinis)/ trunks, swimming hats, towels and flip flops/crocs. They can wear goggles if they wish. **All items must be named. Please also check that all of your child's uniform is named to help make sure that everyone goes home in the correct clothes**!

Verruca socks must be worn if your child has a verruca; these and swimming hats can be paid for via ParentPay and collected from the school office. Earrings **must** be taken out.
