Starting Secondary school September 2025

If your child is in year 6 then you can now apply for a place at secondary school by going to www.westsussex.gov.uk/admissions. The deadline for applications to secondary school is 31st October 2024. Any application received after the deadline will be considered as out of time or late and will not be processed until after all on time applications

You can express up to three preferences for secondary schools. All your preferences will be considered against the oversubscription criteria of your preferred schools. If your child can be offered a place at more than one school listed on the application, they will be offered a place at the higher listed school. Please do not put down the same preference more than once as your child can only be ranked once for each preferred school. Please do not include independent schools, schools where you do not want a place for your child or Elective Home Education as preferences.

Flu Vaccinations

Please complete the form even if you do not wish your child to receive the vaccination. Deadline for completing the form is 20th November. Dear Parent/Guardian

Your child's Flu vaccination is now due!

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on Tuesday 26/11/2024 to offer your child the nasal Flu spray vaccination.

Please complete a consent form for your child to say YES or NO for them to have these vaccines.

This must be completed by a Parent or Legal Guardian with Parental Responsibility

Follow the steps below, **before the closing date and time**, which is at 11am, 3 working days before the school session date above. If you miss the cut off time, the consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination within one of our catch-up clinics.

- Enter the following school code SX125841 and click 'Find School' School codes are unique to each school and site.

If we have not received a completed consent form from you and your child presents themselves to the Immunisation Team during the school session to request vaccination, we may offer them the opportunity to consent for themselves. (Details in the FAQs).

Please note that if we do not receive either a YES or NO consent form, the immunisation team may contact you by email, phone or text to ask for your consent preference.
