It has been wonderful to see so many of you at our Christmas gatherings. The children have thoroughly enjoyed singing, dancing and acting for you all. Thank you for not filming or taking pictures – it was very much appreciated. The North Lancing photo frame was a hit so we will endeavour to have more next year to avoid the queue! Thank you so much for your generous donation to boost our mental health

support resources in school. We raised a fantastic £532. A number of parents have asked whether they can donate online via ParentPay. This is now setup and can be accessed by logging on to Parent Pay. Our House Captains negotiated a whole school non-uniform day if they raised over £400. They achieved this comfortably, so a non-school uniform date will follow. A big thank you to our House Captains for giving out mince pies, biscuits and sweets (and for collecting donations at the end!)

The money raised will help all children, providing access in the classroom to things such as ear defenders, fidgets, quiet spaces and wobble cushions; as well as themed books and specialist support for things such as, time to talk, ELSA, and emotional regulation. It will also allow us to expand our offering to you as parents, with the hosting of parent workshops and groups and an increase in reading materials. Your support for such an important aspect of school life is really appreciated – thank you.
