They achieved this comfortably, so a non-school uniform date will follow. A big thank you to our House Captains for giving out mince pies, biscuits and sweets (and for collecting donations at the end!)

The money raised will help all children, providing access in the classroom to things such as ear defenders, fidgets, quiet spaces and wobble cushions; as well as themed books and specialist support for things such as, time to talk, ELSA, and emotional regulation. It will also allow us to expand our offering to you as parents, with the hosting of parent workshops and groups and an increase in reading materials. Your support for such an important aspect of school life is really appreciated – thank you.
