

We are delighted to announce that we have been successful in securing a tender with a new hot meal provider. Go! Catering will be supplying North Lancing Primary from the summer term after Easter. Their hot meals are cooked fresh from scratch every day in their kitchen in Haywards Heath and they offer a varied menu of meals that provides children with a healthy, nutritious and filling lunch which is delivered hot to the school each day ready to be served.

They understand the importance of children eating a good lunch, in turn helping them achieve their full potential in the afternoon. Therefore, their focus is to provide the children with meals that they will want to eat. See below for their menu for this term as an example.

They are able to cater for children with any allergy or intolerance, and take pride in providing those children who require a specialist meal with a lunch that looks just as good as the main option.

Courtney Orange Visit

Wow! What an amazing event this was.

What a jam-packed day! Our 400 children trained with Commonwealth athlete Courtney Orange.

Each class came into the hall to complete 4 challenges; Spotty dogs, squat jumps, plank shoulder taps and star jumps.

An inspiring Q&A assembly, each class came up with some great questions. Courtney talked about his highs and lows of being an athlete. We learnt that when Courtney was in the middle of his training for the Olympics he suffered a serious knee injury which unfortunately meant he could no longer compete. But he didn't let that stop him and he tried something new, dancing. He showed us some very clever moves and even had some of the teachers up at the front to demonstrate their skills. He talked about remembering a phrase that his teacher told him when he was at school, when things seemed impossible: I CAN DO IT.

Courtney has this phrase stamped onto his mobile performance platform, which he brings along to every school visit.

We really hope that by having this event at our school it has lit a spark in the children to really get excited about sport and realise that getting moving is really fun!

We can't believe how well the fundraising has gone for this event, we have ended up with nearly £5000 which will go towards some much needed sports equipment for our school.

We would like to say a huge THANK YOU! to everyone that took part and to all those that have taken the time to collect sponsors for our school.

We will definitely be keeping you updated on what the money has gone towards, and I'm sure there will be some pictures of lots of happy children using the new equipment.

I know that the children are desperate to receive their prizes for raising money, I'm sure you have probably been asked at home when they will get these. I know I have been asked many, many times! This may take a couple of weeks but I promise they will come.
