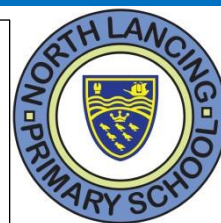

Max C was awarded a Rugby trophy from his team.

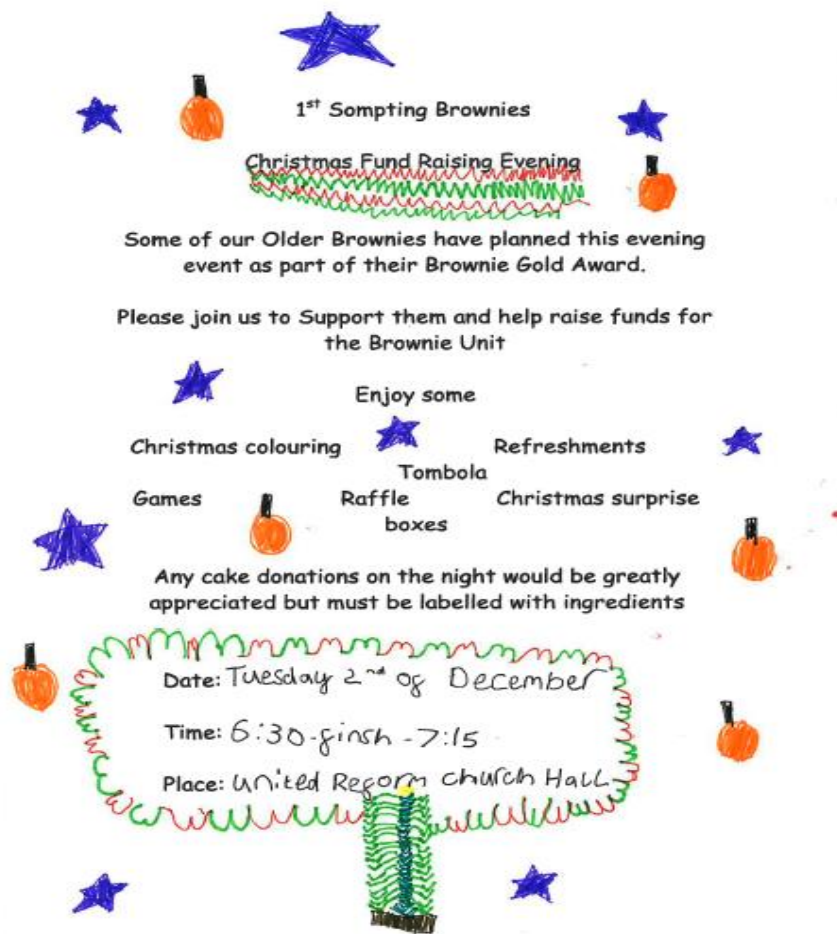

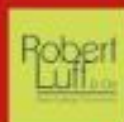
